Dear Colleagues,

For the past two years or so, CVMC Pharmacy has been able to replace outdated medications for District 6 EMS services at no charge to the service. Due to budget constraints, CVMC Pharmacy will no longer be able to offer this service after 30 November 2007.

CVMC Pharmacy will continue to supply District 6 EMS services with medications at cost. After 30 November, if you have expired medications, you can replace them by ordering them through the CVMC Pharmacy using the Pharmacy Order Form available in the EMS Office. Please allow three days for your order to be processed and ready to pick up.

Medications used in the field on patients brought to CVMC ED can be replaced on an exchange basis by the ED RN's from the ED Pyxis.

Medications used during transport on patients being transferred out of CVMC can be replaced on an exchange basis after the run by the RN's from the Pyxis on the unit from which the patient was transferred.
